The PCCW will be selling carnation/artificial roses at all the Masses on May 12th, Mother's day, for a donation of a \$1.00.

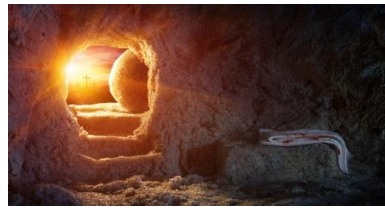

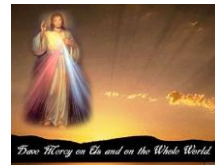
